Cornwall-on-Hudson Donahue Memorial Park

(Riverfront Park)

Major Rules and Regulations

- The park is open sunrise to dusk. Dusk is one half hour before dark.
- Parking of vehicles shall be by permit only. Permits are issued at the Village Hall.
- Permits shall be valid only when displayed on the passenger side of either the rear bumper or back window.
- Permits are valid from January 1st to December 31th of the year issued.
- Parking of vehicles is permitted only in designated areas.
- Maximum speed limit for all vehicles in 10 MPH.
- Children under age thirteen(13) must be accompanied by an adult.
- Swimming, bathing and wading are not permitted.
- No littering. Please use containers.
- Fires must be maintained in barbeque grills/stoves and under the care of an individual 18 years or older.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.
- No domestic animal may be allowed to run at large. Pets must be leashed. It shall be unlawful to permit or allow dogs to defecate or urinate upon the premises.
- Carrying or controlling any type of firearm, fireworks or explosives, except by law enforcement personnel is forbidden.
- No advertising is permitted unless authorized by the Board of Trustees.
- Vending and solicitation is forbidden unless authorized by the Board of Trustees.
- No large group events (18 individuals or more) shall be held unless prior approval has been granted by the Board of Trustees.

BOAT LAUNCH

- An additional permit is required to use a trailer to launch a boat.
- The boat permit should be placed on the vehicle pulling the trailer, next to that vehicle's parking permit.
- · Boat launching shall be permitted only from the designated area.

The Village is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of personal property brought into Donahue Memorial Park, or any Village park.

VIOLATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE PUNISHABLE BY LOSS OF PARK PRIVILEGES, FINES AND OR IMPRISONMENT.
